

2017 4-H Centennial Art Contest

We are in search of a signature piece of art to be representative of 4-H Alberta's 100th Anniversary Celebration. Entries in five different categories (painting, drawing, photography, digital media, and other) will be accepted from any current or past 4-H Alberta member or leader.

There will be a winner declared in each of the five categories. Each will receive a \$250 cash prize. The five category winners will be reproduced on a set of greeting cards which will be available for sale. These five category winners will also be posted on-line to determine a People's Choice winner who will receive a further \$250 cash prize and have their entry reproduced as a limited edition print, which will also be available for sale.

Deadline for entries is August 30, 2016.

Category winners will be announced at the Centennial Launch during Farmfair 2016.

The People's Choice Winner will be announced at the end of January 2017, with the first limited edition print available as an auction item, at WRLF 2017.

2017 4-H Centennial Art Contest

1. Open to all current, and past, 4-H Alberta members and leaders. Entrants who are under the age of majority at the date of entry are eligible to enter the Contest and win a Prize, provided that the parent or legal guardian of the entrant accepts the Prize and the terms and conditions hereof for, and on behalf of, such entrant.
2. Categories:
 - a. Painting – any type
 - b. Drawing – pen, pencil, charcoal
 - c. Photography – colour or black and white
 - d. Digital Media – a still image using any platform
 - e. Other – includes fibre, seeds, intarsia, etc. – maximum depth 1” (should be suitable for photographic reproduction)
3. Criteria:
 - a. May incorporate ‘4-H’ or the logo in some manner
 - b. Must be representative of Alberta 4-H
 - c. Final size should be no smaller than 4X6”.
4. Entries:
 - a. Entrants are limited to a maximum of two entries in each category.
 - b. All entries will require submission of an entry form and a digital photo (highest file size/quality possible, minimum 1 MB) of the entry by Aug. 30, 2016. Entries are to be submitted to celebrate@4hab100.ca with “Art Contest” in the subject line.
5. Selection of Winners and Prizes
 - a. The top 5 finalists in each category will be contacted, by email or phone, by September 30, 2016. They will be required to submit their actual entry by October 15, 2016. Artist is responsible for the transportation of the entry to Box 4560 2nd Flr Prov. Bldg. 6203 49 St. Barrhead AB T7N 1A4. These entries will become the property of 4-H Alberta and will not be returned.
 - b. The winner of each category will be announced at the Centennial Launch (Farmfair, November 2016).
 - c. The five category winners will be posted on the 4-H Alberta centennial website. A People’s Choice winner will be selected based on public votes, and announced end of January 2016.
 - d. Each of the category finalists (25) will receive a set of the greeting cards.
 - e. Each category winner will receive a set of the greeting cards and a \$250 prize (5).
 - f. The people’s choice winner will receive a set of the greeting cards, one of the limited edition prints, and an additional \$250 (1).
 - g. Before being awarded a prize, potential winners, or in the case of a minor his/her parent or legal guardian, will be required to sign and return a full release and indemnity form stating, among other things that he/she grants all consents required to broadcast, publish, disseminate and/or otherwise use his/her name, likeness, sobriquet and voice and all other indicia of personality, in connection with any promotion and/or publicity, and/or for general news and/or for entertainment and/or information purposes at no additional compensation to the potential winner, beyond the awarding of the Prize; accepts the prize as offered; and releases the organizers from any and all liability of any kind arising out of the potential winner’s participation in the contest and receipt and/or use of the prize. In the event the potential winner does not comply with this provision, the organizers shall have the right to disqualify the potential winner, and select an alternate winner, and the organizers shall be fully and completely released and discharged from any liability or responsibility in this regard.

6. Use of Submissions:

- a. The winner of each category will be reproduced on a set of greeting cards, to be available for sale.
- b. The People's Choice winner will be reproduced as a limited edition print, to be available for sale.
- c. Print #1, of the People's Choice winner prints, will be available for auction at WRLF 2017.
- d. Each of the category finalists may be displayed, reproduced, sold, or distributed as is determined by the 2017 4-H Alberta Celebration Steering Committee, without compensation to the artist.

7. Conditions of Entry:

- a. By entering this contest the participants automatically agree to accept and abide by these rules and criteria. All decisions of the organizers with respect to any aspect of this contest, including without limitation the eligibility of entries, are final and binding on all entrants in all matters as they relate to this contest.
- b. The organizers assume no responsibility for garbled, lost, late, delayed, destroyed, or misdirected entries, mail, e-mail or any computer errors or malfunctions. No correspondence shall be entered into except with entrants requesting the rules by mail or requesting the name of the prize winner(s). Organizers do not assume any responsibility for incorrect or inaccurate capture of entry information, technical malfunction, human or technical error, seeding or printing errors, lost, delayed, or garbled data or transmissions, omission, interruption, deletion, defect or failures of any telephone or computer line or network, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof. Entry materials or data that have been tampered with or altered are void. If for any reason, in the opinion of the organizers, in their sole discretion, the contest is not capable of running as originally planned, or if the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the contest is corrupted or adversely affected, including by reason of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond its control, organizers reserve the right to cancel, terminate, modify, amend, extend, or suspend the contest, and/or select a winner from previously received eligible entries. Organizers reserve the right to modify the rules without materially affecting the terms and conditions hereof. Organizers reserve the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual they find to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the contest or to be acting in violation of the rules or otherwise in a disruptive manner. Any attempts to deliberately damage the contest web site or to undermine the legitimate operation of this contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made the organizers reserve the right to seek remedies and damages to the fullest extent of the law. Contest organizers shall not be held responsible for any errors or negligence that may arise or occur in connection with the contest including any damage to an entrant's computer equipment, system, software, or any combination thereof, as a result of their participation in this contest, or from downloading any material from the contest web site.
